The purpose of this application is to determine equitable distribution of funds from the 4-H Leaders Council's approved budget for the Leadership Conference of Regional Teens. Each member who applies and meets the criteria will receive a share of funds in a "pot". All members will be notified of the amount approximately 2 weeks after the application closes. Members may then accept or withdraw the scholarship.

All the required registration paperwork (application, code of conduct and 2 page and medical release form) must accompany this scholarship application. In addition, a check made out to the Monterey County 4-H Council for the entire amount must be included with application. Your family will be reimbursed only the scholarship amount awarded after you attend. Council will award money towards registration only. All other expenses are your responsibility such as gas, travel meals, etc.

If you cannot attend the conference after the fees have been paid, you are responsible for: finding (as your replacement delegate) a "same gender" 4-H member in good standing who meets the conference participation requirements or forfeit all registration fees you sent in.

4-H Members: After your trip, the 4-H Council expects you to share your experience and information with other 4-H members. The options include attending a Council meeting and giving a talk about your experience, or giving a talk at your club's monthly meeting. It is also a courtesy to send a Thank You note for the scholarship funds to the Leader's Council.
