Judging Contest

Judging classes are related to 4-H projects
Each class has four items to rank 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place.

Example: "Pumpkins entered in the County Fair"

Look at the four pumpkins. Use what you know about pumpkins and county fair requirements to determine which of numbered pumpkins you think is 1st place. Then decide which is 2nd place, 3rd place and 4th place.

Let's say you think pumpkin # 2 is the best and should be 1st place. You think pumpkin #4 is next best, then #1 and #3. That makes your judging order **2-4-1-3**. Find that order on your judging sheet and mark it. The more accurate you are, the more points you get.

Top high point winners in Junior, Intermediate and Senior age divisions receive gold medals.

Junior division: 9 to 10 yrs

Intermediate division: 11 to 13 yrs

Senior division: 14 yrs and up
