



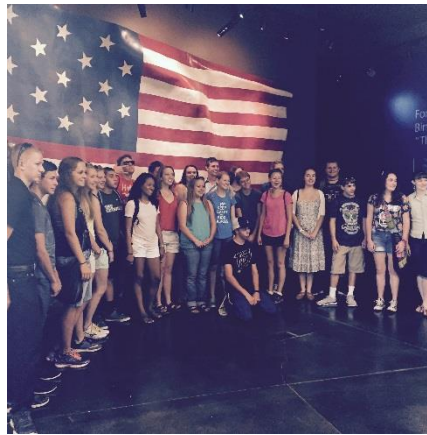
# CITIZENSHIP WASHINGTON FOCUS
