

All members from 5-19 years may participate in Presentation Day. Primary or mini-members will receive participation certificates only. Members4th grade or 9 years of age by January 1st are judged using the Danish system (gold, red or blue). Everyone will receive comment sheets from the judges to help them improve their presentation skills. Members who are awarded a Gold Medal may elect to continue on the Sectional Presentation Day and if a Gold Medal is awarded at Sectional they may advance to the state level competition which is held in May at the University of California Davis.
