

Field Day Dessert Contest 2/4/12

Baked goods need to be checked in between 8:45am and 9:15am at the First Baptist Church in Salinas.

Age categories will be 5-8 years, 9-11 years, 12-14 years and 15 above.

Baked goods Categories:

Chocolate cookies: Anything with chocolate in it or on it! Please bring 15 cookies that are 2 inch in diameter. Bring on non-returnable plate

Brownies and Blondies – Bring your favorite – chewy or cake like, nuts or no nuts, frosted or plain. Must be baked in 9x13 pan. Bring in non-returnable container uncut OR bake in glass pan but cut into 4 large square and bring on non-returnable plate. (Blondies are a brownie type bar that does not have chocolate in the batter)

Mini cupcakes - Any flavor, frosted or unfrosted. Bring 2 dozen on a non-returnable plate.

Rules:

Open to all Monterey county 4-H members except those on the judging committee. Members must have done the baking themselves. Age categories will be 5-8 (No medals awarded) 9-11, 12-14 and 15 above. Only the categories listed above will be judged. 1 entry per category per member. You do not need to be in a Foods or Baking project to compete.

All baked goods must be on/in a non-returnable container or plate. Member name, age and club must be taped on bottom of container and on top. Recipe must be submitted with baked good that includes members name. Additional information may be provided such as the history or variations of the recipe.

A Danish judging method will be used and gold medals may be awarded.

Members of the Dessert committee will judge and award the gold medals. Members attending the Field Day will cast their vote for People's Choice in each category by tasting and scoring the desserts.

4-H Field Day Poster Contest

The Poster Contest is open to all enrolled 4-H members ages 9 to 19, one entry per member. Posters must have been made during the 2010 – 2011 program year. Medals will be awarded to the top entries in each of the following categories:

Juniors grades 4 - 5

Intermediate grades 6 - 8

Seniors grades 9 – 12

Rules & Guidelines

1. Poster topic should be related to 4-H
2. Posters should be no larger than 22”X28” in and no smaller than 11”X14”. Member’s name and club should be written on back.
3. Poster must be on dimensional. Photos, drawings, stickers, die cuts, etc. may be used, however, no copyrighted figures such as Mickey Mouse, Spiderman are allowed. If the 4-H logo is used, no image can be placed or screened over it.
4. Posters must be at 4-H Field Day and check in with Royal Oaks 4-H by 8:45 am to be judged. Posters must be removed at the end of Field Day.
5. No members may be in the Poster Contest are during judging.

Contest Scorecard Poster will be judged using the following criteria:
